To serve the growing needs of our community, Bloomin' Boutique has three facilities all located in Oregon City:

- The Bloomin' Boutique headquarters and "Boutique" storefront on Molalla Avenue serves as the fulfillment center and "store" for high school/adult sized kids
- The "Annex" serves as the fulfillment center for sizes birth through 7/8
- The "Tween Station" serves as the fulfillment center for sizes 10/12 through 14/16

Each facility has a team of volunteers who build care packages for children throughout the tri-county area.

Whether you choose to be a donor, sponsor or volunteer, we appreciate your decision to support Bloomin' Boutique!

It is clear that our dedicated sponsors, donors and volunteers work together – from their hearts – to make a difference in the lives of others. Bloomin' Boutique cannot possibly address all of the challenges these children and their families face, but through collaborative relationships with school counselors, child advocates and family partners, we hope to lighten the load and bring some happiness – and normalcy – into the lives of underserved children. Children of incarcerated parents, children suffering from mental illness or homelessness, children whose parents are struggling to maintain any semblance of a home... there is much to be done – locally – and we rely on the support of individuals and businesses to carry out our mission.

Bloomin' Boutique is an all volunteer organization with no paid staff. Overhead expenses are kept at a low 6%, so **94% of donations go directly to help the kids!** Our shoppers stretch those dollars by seeking out fashionable clothing sales, developing relationships with clothing manufacturers and spending *your* money like it was their last dollar!






Thank You Bloomin'

I am a mom living in Clackamas County and am in my first year of recovery. In August my baby girl named Violet* was born. I have worked really hard to put my life back together after her birth. I have graduated from multiple programs and am on my way to starting my career and finding stable housing. My little girl has grown out of her clothes so quickly and it's hard to buy so many new clothes and supplies in the first year of life. I was so grateful for my housing navigator to tell me that she could ask your organization for help. I couldn't believe the three bags of beautiful brand new clothes she brought to me. My little girl sleeps with the beautiful handmade quilt every night and her big brother loves picking out her outfit. When I get back on my feet I want to come volunteer for your organization.

Thank you for everything you do!

I want to take the time to thank you for the support you give to the most vulnerable youth in our community. On the last day of February 2023, two perfect little twin girls were born. They came into this world a little earlier than expected and had to spend the first month of their lives in the NICU. Their parents have fallen on hard times, are trying to find stable housing and had almost nothing in preparation for their arrival. Once the babies came, the parents spent as much time as they were able with their new babies at the NICU.

The mom to these two lovely twins reached out to me asking if I knew where she could get some baby clothes. It was such a relief to say that I knew exactly who to call: Bloomin' Boutique.

The order was ready the exact same day and I filled every square inch of my vehicle with matching baby outfits, identical twin hand crocheted blankies, a baby bathtub, a baby sleeper, a package of bottles, hand print memento kits, receiving blankets, sleep sacs, lovies, stuffies, play mats, binkies, diapers, wipes and hygiene kits. I was floored with the amount of love that went into the packing of this order.

When I brought the order to the parents and got to hold the newborn babies, their mom was beside herself with emotion. She could not believe there was an organization that would be willing to jump into action and help out a family that they did not even know.

This family is working hard to get their life back on track and your support is a hand up on their journey to finding stability. It is so heartwarming to know that we have Bloomin' Boutique to go to when we find little babies in need of a healthy start.



Q&A

Q: You value the initial care package at \$500... what do the children receive?

A: An initial care package includes 1 pair of shoes, 4 pants, 7 shirts, 7 underwear (don't forget the bras!), 10 socks, 1 coat/hoodie... then add on the hygiene products, backpack, educational toys, stuffies, school supplies, craft kits and maybe a ball or frisbee. Pillow, pillowcase and blanket... oh my! Each care package is carefully coordinated and curated to fit the particular child. We try our best to include something that they have indicated they wish to have... a favorite color, activity or character. Our volunteers can spend up to 5 hours assembling just one care package!

Agencies will also notify us with specific needs that are not normally in our mix, but we reach out to our resources to fulfill the need if we can. For example, we were able to provide beds for a family that had lost everything in a fire. We make every effort to provide the necessities and respond quickly with those needing immediate assistance.

Q: How do you fund your mission to provide only NEW clothing?

A: We are fortunate to have a number of generous individuals and businesses who believe in what we do. In addition, we organize several fundraising events throughout the year along with encouraging people to give through clothing drives. Lastly, we have a gifted grant writer who secures grants from businesses and foundations. As a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization, any donations are tax deductible.

Q: As an individual, how can I help?

A: There are up to 15 ways to help and if everyone gave just a little bit, we can continue to meet the increasing demand within our local communities.

- Organize a clothing drive to fill our shelves with basic necessities... socks, underwear, pajamas... any NEW clothing items!
 - Donate gift cards to enable us to fulfill special need requests and "fill in the gaps" as needed
 - Donate funds... one time or monthly, money CAN buy (almost) anything! And our shoppers are always scouting out the deals to stretch your dollars!
 - Redirect your bottle refund and Fred Meyer Rewards to credit Bloomin' Boutique. Two bags of returned bottles will buy a pair of shoes for a child!
